“I want to paint a special atmosphere of its own around the objects I paint, highlighting the shadows and tones of colours in the different materials thereof, for example glass porcelain in combination with fruits and flowers and still life objects in combination with living objects.”

Asia Uziakova was born in Saint Petersburg, Russia, in 1976. Since her childhood days, in fact since she was 11 years old, she has been preoccupied with painting. She visited the Saint Petersburg High School of Art and got a BA from the Pedagogical University of A.I. Gertsena in Graphics and Pedagogy. Her teachers were Gawrichkow, Streltsowa, Kornilowa and Grigoriew. She graduated with the painting *Self-Portrait at the St. Nicholas Cathedral*.

From 1998 onwards, Asia took part in many group exhibitions and Plein-Air Festivals in Russia and abroad. As a result, examples of her work can be found in galleries and private collections in Germany, Russia, Poland, Macedonia, Greece and France.
